

Host a See. Love. Vote. Postcard Party

Invite 3-5 friends to join you in writing messages on NETWORK postcards to Catholic voters as part of NETWORK Advocates' nonpartisan See. Love. Vote. campaign.

This is the tactic for you if...

- You enjoy hosting and creating an atmosphere that energizes others to act
- You are excited to connect with Catholic voters and share what you are seeing in your community, how you are responding with love, and why you are voting in the 2026 midterm elections
- You are looking for opportunities to help get out the vote
- You like writing letters and postcards!

Why this tactic matters...

People of faith and goodwill across the country are voting in the midterm elections this fall, because we take seriously our call to love our neighbors. Together, we are voting to build a country where all of us have what we need to thrive.

Writing postcards is an opportunity to energize Catholic voters by connecting voting with loving our neighbors and making life better in our communities! We know that stories are powerful, and this is an opportunity to share yours!

What to do...

Start planning your postcard party!

1. Choose a date for your event sometime in August.
2. Consider your set-up. Are you gathering folks in your home, a library, a church, a school, or somewhere else?
3. Invite friends, family, and community members to your party. If the space allows it, consider inviting guests to bring a dish or beverages to share.

4. Plan to provide enough pens and stamps for everyone who will attend.
 - a. **The cost of a postcard stamp is 65¢. As host you will receive six stamps from NETWORK to get you started, and are responsible for any stamps beyond that number.**
5. At the beginning of the event, introduce your guests to the See. Love. Vote. nonpartisan campaign to get out the vote in the 2026 midterm elections. As the host, you must sign the nonpartisan pledge that was included in your postcard kit, and read it to your guests. Ask for a show of hands to affirm commitment to the pledge.
6. Pass out the address list and offer the sample message as guidance for postcard writers. Encourage writers to consider what they are seeing in their communities, how they are responding with love, and why they are voting.
7. Gather the postcards at the end of your event and mail them by the end of the month.
